Ammerman, who will serve as Guest Speaker at POVA's Biennial Reunion in August. Meeting MG Ammerman was a long overdue pleasure.

Outgoing CO Michael Barger is replaced by COL Jessie Manning of Dallas, TX. It was a great pleasure working with COL Barger. COL Manning has expressed his interest in maintaining ties between his Command and POVA.

COL Michael G. Barger Former CO, 2d PSYOP Group

Colonel Michael Barger graduated from the US Military Academy at West Point in 1988, and was commissioned a Second Lieutenant of Infantry. His career included leadership assignments with the 4<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division, the 6<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division, and the 501<sup>st</sup> Infantry (Airborne). He has held multiple Civil Affairs and PSYOP positions during his career, and commanded the 17<sup>th</sup> PSYOP Battalion from 2008 to 2011.

His military education included the Infantry Officer Basic and Advanced Courses, Ranger School, Airborne School, Air Assault School, PSYOP Officer Qualification Course, Russian Basic Military Language Courses, and the Army War College. He has served multiple tours in Iraq. He has been awarded Airborne badges from Canada, the United Kingdom, the Netherlands, Brazil, and the Philippines.

A native of Juneau, AK, COL Barger holds the B.S. degree in Military History from West Point, a Master of Military Arts and Sciences degree from US Army Command and General Staff School, and a Master of Strategic Studies from the Army War College. COL Barger is married to the former Donna Ann Perniiola; she their daughter Kristen will accompany him to his new assignment.

Colonel Barger's replacement is COL Jesse C. Manning, a synopsis of whose bio is included below. Welcome Aboard COL Manning; POVA is here in support of you and your command.

Colonel Jesse C. Manning was commissioned a Second Lieutenant of Infantry in May 1989 following graduation from the New Mexico Military Institute. He also holds a BA degree in Criminal Justice and Criminology from the University of Texas. His military education includes the Infantry Officer Basic Course, Infantry Leaders Course, the PSYOP Qualification Course, Airborne Course, Infantry Captains Career Course, Parachute Operations Mishap Prevention Course, Air Assault Course, Jumpmaster Course, Command and General Staff College, and Advanced Joint Professional Military Education Course.

As a member of the Texas National Guard, COL Manning served as Infantry Platoon Leader, Executive Officer, Battalion Motor Officer, and Battalion S6 with the 3/144<sup>th</sup> Mech Infantry Battalion and as a Tank Platoon commander with 1/112<sup>th</sup> Tank Battalion.

COL Manning has served multiple foreign tours including tours in Kosovo, Afghanistan and Iraq. He has also commanded the 345<sup>th</sup> Tactical PSYOP Company and Commander of HHC 451<sup>st</sup> Civil Affairs Battalion. He most recently commanded 2d Battalion of the 354<sup>th</sup> Regiment (BCT). In his civilian occupation, COL Manning serves as a Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) Officer and as an Unmanned Aerial System Pilot for the City of Arlington, TX. He is married to the former Melissa A. Martinez, and has a son, Christopher, and daughter Brianna.

On the evening prior to the Change of Command, POVA First VP Chad Spawr attended the farewell banquet for COL Barger, and presented him with a POVA Active Duty Membership certificate and the new POVA Challenge Coin. COL Barger's banquet was attended by many members of his command and families, including BG Richard K. Sele, Deputy Commanding General, U.S. Army Civil Affairs and Psychological Operations Command (Airborne), and BG Christopher W. Stockel, Commanding General, 351 Civil Affairs Command

Chad,

Many thanks for the newsletter and your gracious comments on my career. Here's an important note of clarification. Your note at the bottom of page 5, "the Army's USASOC HQ at Ft. Bragg being named in honor of Major General Robert A. McClure, considered by many to be the father of modern Special Operations and PSYOP." In fact, he was officially designated as the father of special warfare. At the USASOC headquarters entrance, this plaque states simply, but eloquently, IN MEMORY OF MG ROBERT ALEXIS McCLURE. 4 MAR 1897-1 JAN 1957, THE FATHER OF ARMY SPECIAL WARFARE. BUILDING DEDICATED 19 JANUARY 2001. I was honored to be asked by the CG, USASOC, to present introductory remarks for the dedication ceremony on 19 January 2001.

Also, the photo of my book in your newsletter is the original edition, published by NDU Press in 1982. University Press of Kansas published the revised edition in 2002, which includes a new chapter on Vietnam. This book is still in print.

Thanks to Al for his update and clarification.
